SUBJECT: **CONDUCT OF ADVANCED TRAINING COURSE FOR LEADERS OF ADULTS (ATC-LOA)**

1. The Boy Scouts of the Philippines, Western Mindanao Region is pleased to announce the conduct of the Advanced Training Course for Leaders of Adults (ATC-LOA) to be hosted by Zamboanga del Norte-Dipolog-Dapitan City Council, BSP on 23 February to 2 March 2019 at BSP Scouts Camp, Compra, Liloy, Zamboanga del Norte.
2. **Qualifications for Admission:**
 - 2.1 Must be currently registered with the BSP
 - 2.2 Must be in good health as certified by a registered physician
 - 2.3 Must be a graduate of a Basic Training Course (BTC) and have received the Basic Training Completion Certificate
3. **Course Fee:** Each participant shall be charged FIVE THOUSAND PESOS (PHP5,000.00) to cover meals and snacks, souvenir items, training materials, handouts and other administrative cost. Meals will start on February 22, 2019 (Dinner) until March 2, 2019.
4. **Deadline:** Duly accomplished Application Form must be submitted to Western Mindanao Region a week before the scheduled training course plus a reservation fee of Two Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (P2,500.00), a non-refundable but transferable and to be remitted to host council (contact host council for further inquiry on the reservation fee). Admission to the course shall be on a first come first serve basis.
5. **Transportation:** Transportation shall be borne and arranged by the participants to and from the venue and expected to report a day before the scheduled training course for briefings and instructions.

 - 6.8 Scout Knife /Bolo
 - 6.9 Toiletries and others
 - 6.10 Rain gears
 - 6.11 Flashlight (battery/solar)
 - 6.12 Extra cloth good for 7 days
