**ADMINISTRATION OF THE REVISED PHILIPPINE INFORMAL READING  
INVENTORY (Phil-IRI) ASSESSMENT**

To: Public Schools District Supervisors/ Districts In-Charge  
Elementary School Heads  
District and School Reading Coordinators

1. To measure and describe the learners' reading performance in both English and Filipino languages and to provide the division data for planning, designing/redesigning the reading instruction of teachers and the school's reading programs, all public elementary schools in the division are required to administer the revised Philippine Informal Reading Inventory (Phil-IRI) assessment from **June 24, 2019 to July 31, 2019**.
2. All students in Grades 3 to 6 will undergo the Phil-IRI Group Screening Test (GST) in Filipino, while students in Grades 4-6 will undergo the GST in English. Students identified to be performing below level of expectation (those with a total Raw Score below 14 in Phil-IRI GST) should undergo further assessment through the individually administered Phil-IRI graded passages. Group assessments must be conducted within class time while individual assessments may be conducted outside class hours.
3. All Filipino subject teachers for Grades 3 to 6 and English subject teachers for Grades 4 to 6 can administer the Phil-IRI GST in their respective classes. ELLN-trained teachers can administer the Phil-IRI Graded Passages to individual students who need further assessment.
4. School heads are tasked to conduct orientation to teachers on the proper administration of the revised Phil-IRI from **June 17-21, 2019** while Public Schools District Supervisors shall monitor the conduct of orientation to teachers and administration of the Phil-IRI assessment.
