Subject : **SIMULTANEOUS CLINIQUING FOR 2019 RSPC QUALIFIERS**

1. In preparation for the 2019 Regional Schools Press Conference (RSPC) scheduled on November 11-14, 2019 at the Schools Division of Nueva Vizcaya, a Simultaneous Cliniquing for 2019 RSPC Qualifiers shall be conducted on the following dates and venues:

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2. Winning coaches in the Individual Writing Contests and champion coach in the Group Contests shall serve as trainers for the Simultaneous Cliniquing for RSPC Qualifiers.
3. The **PULL-OUT, ONE-ON-ONE CLINIQUING SCHEME** shall be adopted to ensure that all RSPC qualifiers master the required competencies in the categories where they are competing in.
4. RSPC qualifiers in the Individual Writing Contests are required to accomplish **fifteen (15) outputs** while contestants in the Group Contests shall produce **ten (10) outputs**.
5. If performance tasks, seatworks, quizzes, unit tests, or other similar activities are done during the schedules of Cliniquing and RSPC, the pupil/student-contestants should be **EXEMPTED AND SHOULD BE GIVEN THE HIGHEST SCORE**, provided they accomplish the required number of outputs. Catch-Up classes shall be done upon their return so they can cope with missed lessons.
6. School Heads are required to devise and implement a Substitution Plan to ensure that classes of teacher-coaches will be properly attended.
7. Education Program Supervisors and Schools District Supervisors are tasked to monitor the conduct of the activity and the implementation of Catch-Up Classes and Substitution Plan.
8. Foods, snacks, and travelling expenses of participants shall be shouldered by each school to be charged against school MOOE/local fund/Campus Journalism Fund, subject to usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
