The objectives of this event are the following:

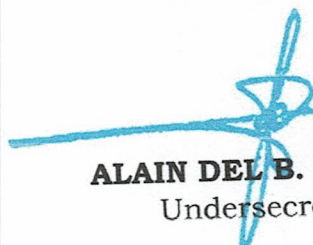
1. salute and pay homage to Filipino Olympians who represented and brought honor and glory to the country;
